Official statement regarding Llanelli AFC

It has been reported in certain publications and on unofficial websites that if Llanelli AFC fails to comply with the UEFA Financial Fair Play Test by the end of September then it would affect their application for the FAW Domestic Licence to play in the Corbett Sport Welsh Premier League next season. This is not the case.

It is true that if the Reds do not satisfy the financial criteria set out by UEFA by September 30th then one possible sanction is to suspend them from European competition but this will not affect their right to play in the top flight of Welsh football.

Llanelli and every other Corbett Sports Welsh Premier League club must reach stringent financial targets by April 2013 in order to allow them to participate in the league the following season.

Llanelli's woes spread to the field on Saturday as they collapsed to a 0-3 home defeat to Newtown. Three Reds' players were also red carded which means Ashley Evans, Chris Venables and Luke Bowen will miss next Friday's visit to Park Avenue to take on Aberystwyth Town

Multi-goal start to Womens Premier League

Two goals in two minutes by Katie Thomas and Steph Hughson on the hour mark secured the scalp of Swansea for Llanidloes. Sarah Adams' 76th minute strike set up an exciting climax to the match but the visitors failed to grab a point.

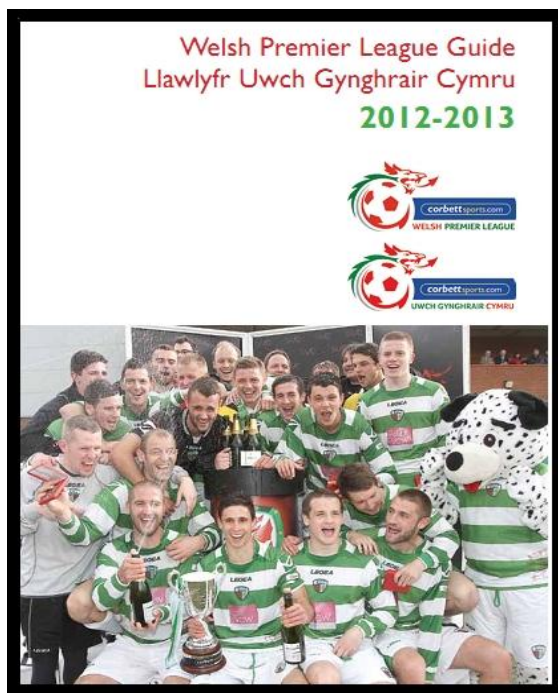
